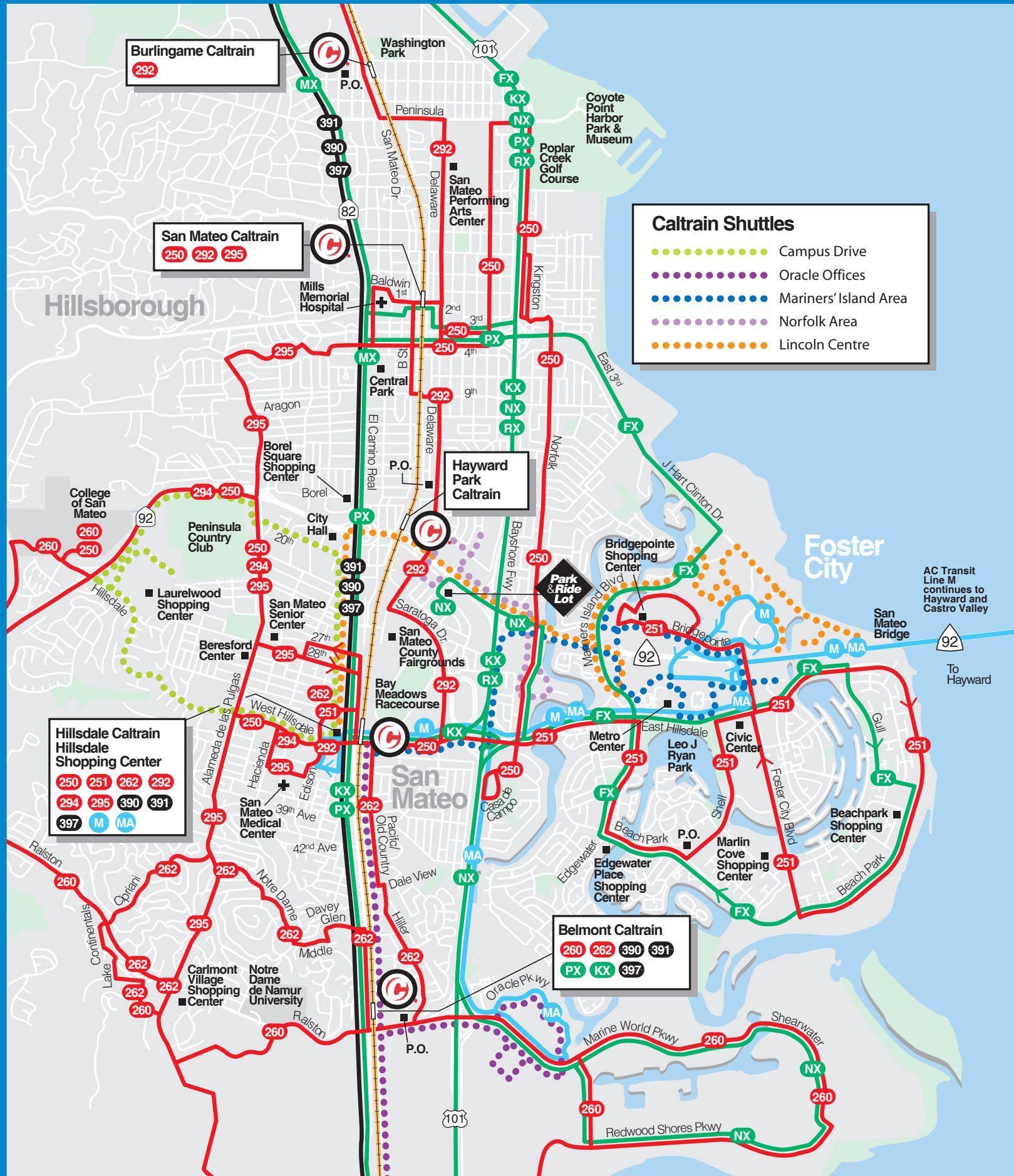


Keeping San Mateo On The Move

Business Transit Guide

The San Mateo County Transit District offers an extensive network of public transit in San Mateo making it easy for employees to leave their car at home and take transit. Buses, trains and shuttles provide vital connections to business and commercial centers.



SamTrans provides local and express bus service in San Mateo, including service along El Camino Real every 15 minutes. SamTrans operates more than a dozen routes within San Mateo. Whether it's a local trip or a express to San Francisco, SamTrans has the route for you.



Caltrain operates 96 weekday trains between San Francisco and San Jose, with commute-time service to Gilroy. San Mateo is home to two Baby Bullet stations, providing a quicker service to San Mateo than battling traffic along Highway 101. Caltrain customers using a Caltrain two-zone Monthly Pass ride SamTrans local service for free, making connections from Caltrain to SamTrans a breeze.



San Mateo is home to one of the county's best shuttle systems with service between Caltrain and a number of local businesses and commercial areas. Companies and business parks currently served include: Atrium, Waters and Peninsula business parks, Oracle, Bayshore Corporation and Mariners' Island.



SamTrans has bike racks on its buses with room for two bikes, and Caltrain provides a dedicated car for up to 32 bikes. Bike lockers are a great way to ease your commute and are available at the three Caltrain stations in San Mateo.



Caltrain offers employers the opportunity to enroll in the Caltrain Go Pass program which allows employees to ride at a deep discount. The Go Pass currently has 17,000 users and is a great benefit for your employees. In addition to the Caltrain Go Pass program, several cost-saving fare options are offered by Caltrain and SamTrans including discount tokens and a variety of pass products.



Employers can receive a tax deduction of up to \$110 for subsidizing transit passes for employees. Many employers purchase Commuter Checks for employees, who use them to purchase transit passes.
