## **Operations Planning (Job ID 901186)**

 The selected Intern will assist in data collection, analysis and report development related to ridership. Working with the Operations Planning (Ops Planning) team to review and develop bus schedules and service plans ensuring accuracy for the coming run book. Work will include using scheduling software, HASTUS, to ensure quality and completeness of data and information and assisting with reporting needs to the National Transit Database.
