





Project Purpose and Need

The at-grade crossing of Broadway in Burlingame is ranked #1 on the California Public Utilities Commission's Grade Separation Priority List.

The crossing contributes to congestion, delays, and a lack of east-west connectivity



Project Solution

The Broadway Grade Separation Project will:

- **improve safety** by eliminating the at-grade crossing.
- elevate Caltrain's tracks and platforms above Broadway.
- reduce delays, congestion, and emissions; and improve east-west connectivity.



Previous Board Actions

On **March 2, 2023**, in **Resolution 2023-16**, the JPB:

- Resolved that utilizing the CMGC project delivery method pursuant to Public Utilities Code
 Section 103395 for the Broadway Grade Separation Project would be in the best interest of the
 JPB as it would accomplish the objectives of providing project features not achievable through
 the traditional DBB project delivery method and would likely also reduce project costs and
 expedite completion; and
- Authorized staff to proceed with using the CMGC project delivery method.



Procurement Background

- On August 16, 2023, the JPB issued Request for Proposals number 23-J-C-040 to solicit
 Construction Manager General Contractor (CMGC) Pre-Construction Services, including:
 - Performing design reviews for constructability, staging, and sequencing
 - Providing input on long-lead material procurement times, pricing, and alternatives
 - Optimizing construction packaging to expedite construction; and
 - Providing other construction inputs during design to promote a sound project approach
- On October 11, 2023, the following three firms and joint ventures submitted Proposals:
 - Clark / Shimmick Joint Venture, San Francisco, CA
 - Flatiron-Herzog Joint Venture (FHJV), Concord, CA
 - Kiewit Infrastructure West Co., Fairfield, CA



Procurement Background

- FHJV was determined to be the highest-ranked Proposer by the evaluation committee
- FHJV was found to possess the requisite qualifications and experience including CMGC delivery and recent projects including:
 - I-5 North Coast Corridor CMGC, San Diego, CA
 - Mid-Coast Transit Corridor CMGC Project, San Diego, CA
 - Brightline Phase 2 Expansion Zone 4, Orlando, FL
- Staff successfully negotiated the Pre-Construction Phase fee with FHJV, conducted a price
 analysis for the base contract and optional construction fee, and determined the price to be fair
 and reasonable.

Budget Impact

- The Broadway Burlingame Grade Separation Project was originally approved by the Board in Fiscal Year 2018.
- Amendments since then increased the project's budget to \$27,913,000, funded by the TA for \$23,413,000 and the City of Burlingame for \$2,000,000.
- This contract can be funded within the approved project budget.



Staff Recommendation

- **Award** a Contract to Flatiron-Herzog Joint Venture, a joint venture headquartered in Concord, California (FHJV), to provide Services for the Project for an amount of \$2,500,000.
- Authorize the Executive Director or designee to execute a contract with FHJV in full
 conformity with the terms and conditions set forth in the solicitation documents and
 negotiated agreement, and in a form approved by legal counsel.
