Everyday Heroes. Extraordinary Community.

Who makes your community a better place every day? Think about the people who help, teach, create, protect, heal, build, grow, or inspire others. They might be a teacher, crossing guard, bus operator, caregiver, artist, nurse, mechanic, firefighter, librarian, grocery worker, coach, farmer, scientist, or someone in your own family.

Create an artwork that **celebrates one or more of your everyday heroes and shows how SamTrans helps connect people, places, and communities**. Show how transportation helps everyday heroes get where they're needed and keeps our community connected.

PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES: Student work will be judged against others in the same grade. Artwork must be original and created by **students only**.

- ☐ Students can submit one artwork. Schools can submit up to 50 artworks total.
- ☐ The student's name, grade, school, and teacher must be written on the back of the artwork.
- ☐ 'SamTrans' must be visible in some way. (on or outside the bus, logo, bus stop, riders, bus operator, etc).
- ☐ If buildings or landmarks are used, they must be located in San Mateo County.
- ☐ Artwork should be created on **9-inch-high x 12-inch-wide white** paper in a horizontal orientation to fit on the scanner used to make the wrap.
- ☐ No exceptions – submissions not meeting these requirements will be disqualified.

MEDIA: Media can include paint, crayon, felt pen, pastel, collage, and mixed media.

- ☐ The use of bold, rich color is required! Avoid using colored pencils and avoid leaving lots of white space on the canvas.
- ☐ Original artwork in digital media (Illustrator, Photoshop, etc) is accepted. Colors shown in digital artwork are for reference only and may not match the final printed product due to variations in the print production process. **NO GENERATIVE AI ARTWORK ACCEPTED.**

RELEASE FORM: All artwork must be accompanied by the Release Form on the next page. A guardian must sign the form for each participating student. Please email **Allison Gamlen** at agamlen@smcoe.org with questions.

SUBMISSIONS: All entries (including digital) must be delivered **FLAT** (not rolled or folded) to [Allison Gamlen, San Mateo County Office of Education, 101 Twin Dolphin Drive, Redwood City], **up until December 4, 2026 at 5 p.m.**

JUDGING: All entries are judged on creativity, artistic merit, and theme interpretation. Decisions are final. Winners will be notified by e-mail.

RECOGNITION: A total of twelve winners will be selected. Winners will be recognized at the Art Takes A Bus Ride event in **May 2027**. All artwork will be on display at SMCOE. **Artwork will not be returned.**
