

Public Sector Support



- **Federal**
 - MAP-21 created Transportation Alternatives Program
 - Includes Safe Routes to School
- **State**
 - SB 99/AB 101 created Active Transportation Program
 - Consolidates \$129 million annually
 - 50% for statewide programs, 10% to rural areas, 40% to urban areas
- **Local**
 - MTC implements Regional Competitive ATP

Funding Opportunities



- **Statewide ATP**
 - \$183 million awarded through Call for Projects
 - Projects not selected distributed to MPO program Aug. 20
- **MTC Program**
 - Call for Projects ended July 24
 - 13 applications for \$27.8 million
 - Atherton, Belmont, Colma, East Palo Alto, Hillsborough, Pacifica, San Carlos, San Mateo, South San Francisco, Woodside, San Mateo County
 - Safe Routes to School
 - \$11.9 million for Bay Area Bike Share expansion
 - State approves funding in November

- **Bike racks on buses**
- **Contributed \$25,000 to county's funding of Active Transportation Coordinator**
- **Manages "Connect Redwood City!" Last-mile program**
- **Partner in Bay Area Bike Share program**

Bay Area Bike Share


- One year after launch in August 2013
- Bikeshare use disproportionately in San Francisco
- Redwood City lowest ridership in system

City	% of Trips	% of Population
San Francisco	89.5%	40.9%
Redwood City	0.5%	3.9%
Palo Alto	1.2%	3.3%
Mountain View	2.5%	3.8%
San Jose	6.3%	48.1%

- Stations too close



- **Modify Redwood City System**
 - Relocating 2 stations in fall
 - Stanford University location
 - County location
- **Bike Share Expansion**
 - 300 more bikes coming to Bay Area
 - Adding 3 more next spring
 - Locations to be determined
 - Coordinating with City of San Mateo on expanding Bay Area Bike Share
