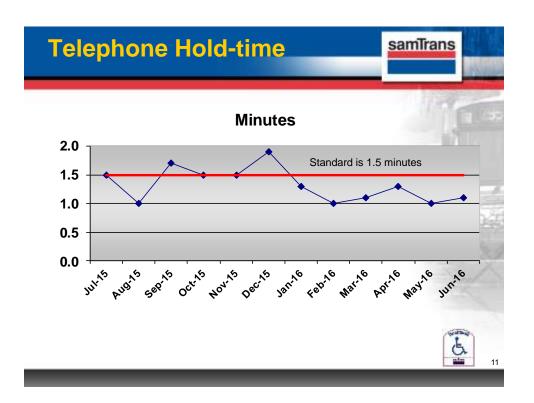


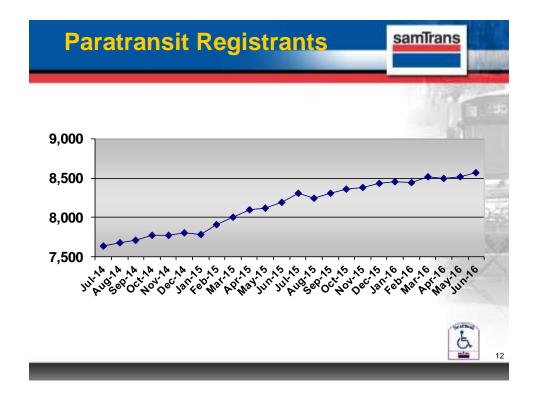
- · Ridership declined during the last 6 months

- · Fleet reliability remains very high

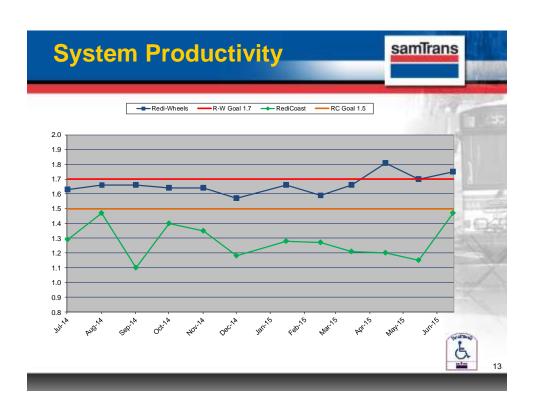

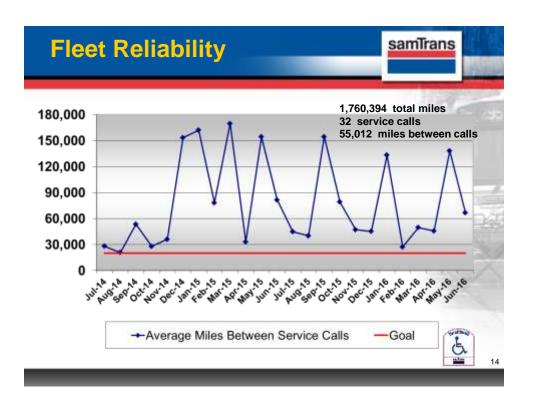










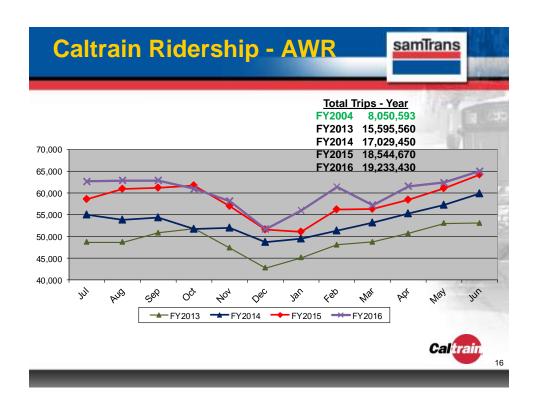


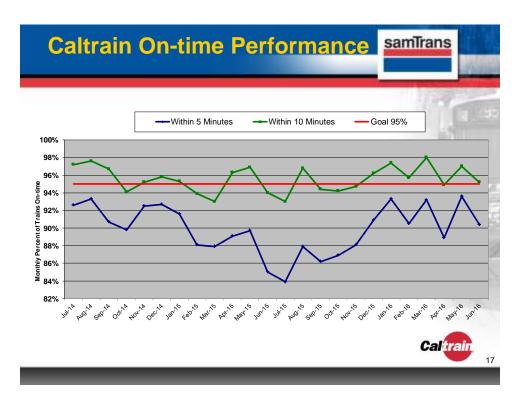
FY 2016 Paratransit Highlights samirans



- Maintained zero-denial record

- Ridership increased 9.4% to 360,010 trips in FY2016
- Lifeline fares remain unchanged at \$1.75
- · Effective January 1, 2016 the regular fare increased 50 cents to \$4.25
- Effective July 1, 2016 the Agency fare increased 50 cents to \$5.00







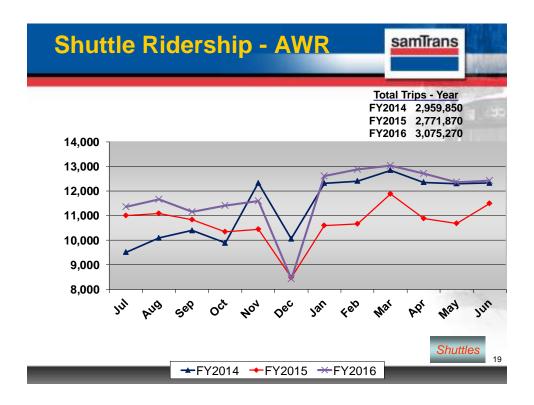
FY2016 Caltrain Highlights



- AWR increased 3.2% from 58,367 to 60,219
- Total ridership increased 3.7% from 18,544,670 trips to 19,233,230 trips
- The Base Fare was increased 50 cents effective February 28, 2016
- OTP was down 0.7%, from 90.2% in FY 2015 to 89.5% in FY 2016
- Purchased 16 used Bombardier rail cars, 11 placed into service
- · 4 bridge projects completed in San Mateo
- 2 bridge projects completed in San Francisco
